Dyeing at a Time-Tested Dyer's Shop

Kyoyuzen Plant Tour and Hands-on Dyeing Experience

Since its founding 100 years ago, Kamedatomi has developed traditional *Kyoyuzen* Kyoto-style patterns used to dye kimono fabric. The shop has grown popular lately for using those patterns on aloha shirts and other modern pieces. Participants tour the dyeing plant and learn about *Kyoyuzen*. In the hands-on part of the course, participants dye a rooster pattern by distinctive Kyoto painter Ito Jakuchu onto a hand towel, and a chrysanthemum pattern onto a tote bag. Beginners and repeat guests alike are invited to enjoy the beauty of traditional patterns.
